## ELIGIBILITY

All BWS Signature and Life members may enter regardless of place of residence. Other artists must be 18 years of age or older and must reside in one of the following: Delaware, District of Columbia, Maryland, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Virginia or West Virginia.

All entries must be original paintings, entirely the work of the entrant, and free from any copyright infringement. No class or workshop paintings. No copies or likenesses of other artists' work. Compositions

based on photographs must use photos taken by the artist or be the sole property of the artist.

Entries must have been completed within the last five years and NOT previously exhibited in prior BWS Mid-Atlantic exhibitions.

Works must be watermedia paintings on natural or synthetic paper, paperboard, clayboard, or equivalent. Paper may be mounted to a rigid smooth substrate using archival materials. No canvas.

## SIZE

No side of the painting visible within the mat can be less than 10 inches. Frames must not exceed 48" in either height or width.

## PRESENTATION

All paintings must be framed in wood or metal. Mats, if used, must be plain white, cream or light gray with an optional colored liner. Glazing (glass), if used, must be Plexiglas for shipped paintings and for works larger than half-sheet (approx. 333 square inches). Floated paintings must use spacers. Works varnished before framing will not require glazing. Backing must be archival. Framing must be professional in appearance with clean mats, frames without visible damage, and clean glazing without noticeable scratches. Frames must be suitably wired and ready to hang. Poorly matted or framed works are subject to disqualification.

## RIGHTS, RESPONSIBILITIES AND LIABILITY

BWS reserves the right to review all delivered entries for conformance to specifications outlined in the prospectus and the right to refuse any work that does not match the submitted digital entry.

All paintings must be for sale, be priced at your current market value, and committed to the exhibition for the duration. No price changes will be allowed. Paintings that sell during the exhibition may be removed only after the end of the exhibition. A 35% commission will be taken.

Every reasonable care will be exercised in handling the art work submitted. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist. Artists may be charged if paintings require repair by a framer.

In submitting work for consideration, all entrants give permission to BWS and BlackRock to use images of selected works for publicity, education and reproduction in the catalog.

## ENTRY PROCEDURE

## DIGITAL ENTRIES

You may submit one or two images, but only one may be selected for exhibition. Only digital entries will be accepted. Files must be high resolution (300dpi), JPG format, 1950 pixels (or 6.5 inches) on the longest dimension, RGB. Name your files LASTNAME-first initial-A or B-title. For example: DOE-J-A-FirstPaintingTitle. Email your entries to **BWSMidAtl@gmail.com** with your name in the **subject line**. (For example: DOE-J entry) Include your name, address and phone in the body of the message. Or, mail your CD, labeled with your name and painting titles.

If you are mailing your entry and would like to be notified by mail, include a SASE with your entry items. Notification to online entrants will be via email. A list of all selected works will be posted on the BWS website on May 4, 2019.

## DELIVERY OF ACCEPTED WORK

If unable to hand-deliver, you will receive detailed shipping instructions. Handling fee for shipped paintings: \$75 for AirFloat boxes or similar; \$90 for other packing materials. Paintings must arrive by May 28, 2019.
