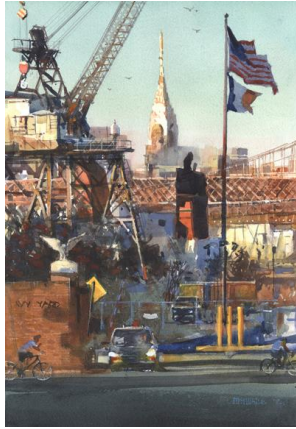


Baltimore Watercolor Society two-day workshop:

March 27 & 28, 2014 at the Hawthorn Center, Columbia, MD



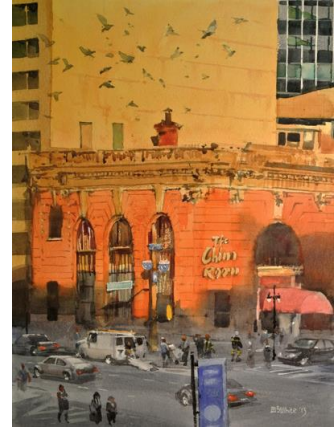

We are pleased and privileged to have the accomplished Baltimore artist **Stewart White, AWS, NWS** as a workshop instructor this spring. Stewart’s work has been exhibited multiple times in both American Watercolor Society and National Watercolor Society shows, and he is a signature member of both. Stewart focuses on plein air painting, and he is a Grand Prize Winner of the prestigious Easton Plein Air Festival. On March 27 & 28 he will conduct a two-day workshop focusing on plein air painting in watercolor. Participants will learn how Stewart approaches watercolor painting from beginning to knowing when to stop. Learn how to create moods, temperature and fresh washes in watercolor working from slides, photographs, still life, the figure and en plein air. This workshop will give you the tools to confidently lay down a variety of washes, work wet-in-wet with predictable results, see dynamic compositions, and approach any subject with effective strategies to execute a successful painting. The workshop will consist of a morning demo, class drills and studies recreating the demo, an afternoon demo (outdoors if weather permits), class painting time (again outdoors, weather permitting, or you can paint inside if you prefer), and class critiques. A supply list will be posted on the BWS Membership Website.
